Notice is hereby given that a meeting of the Commissioners Court of Archer County, Texas will be held on Monday, September 22, 2014 at 10:00 a.m. at the Commissioner's courtroom, Archer County Courthouse Annex, 112 E. Walnut, Archer City, Texas to consider the Agenda listed in this Notice. Please note that the Court retains the right to consider items listed on this Agenda in no particular order. If lunch is observed in which a quorum of the Court will be present, the Court will recess to an announced location and the expected time of return if there is a need to reconvene back into open session to address remaining agenda items.

As authorized by Chapter 551 of the Texas Government Code, the Commissioner's Court of Archer County, Texas reserves the right to adjourn into Executive Session at any time during the course of this meeting to discuss only those specific matters listed on the Action Agenda that are allowed for Executive Session consideration in Chapter 551.

Note: In the event that the Court convenes into Executive Session, only voting members of the Commissioners Court are authorized to enter into Executive Session unless otherwise and specifically authorized by the Court in accordance with law.

RULES FOR ADDRESSING THE COMMISSIONER'S COURT: UNLESS YOU ARE SPECIFICALLY QUESTIONED BY THE COURT, ANYONE WISHING TO ADDRESS THE COURT ON A LISTED AGENDA ITEM, SHALL PLEASE RAISE YOUR HAND TO BE RECOGNIZED BEFORE SPEAKING.

C. PUBLIC COMMENTS—PRESENTATIONS OR MISCELLANEOUS REPORTS—DISCUSSION ITEMS (No vote will be taken on any of these items)

PUBLIC COMMENT NOTE: Anyone wishing to address the Court during Public Comments is required to register your name on the Clerk's registry prior to the meeting, and indicate which item or subject you wish to address. Speakers are limited to THREE (3) minutes maximum, and if there are more than three speakers who wish to address the same item, the Court reserves the right to limit speakers. **THE COURT CANNOT DELIBERATE OR ACT ON MATTERS NOT LISTED ON THE AGENDA.**

D. CONSENT AGENDA: All items listed are considered to be routine business by the Court and will be enacted with one motion unless any item is removed by the Court. Inquiries for clarification, additional information or explanation are allowed, but there will be no individual deliberative action allowed or considered on an item unless a member of the Commissioners Court requests such consideration, at which time, the item will be removed from the Consent Agenda and placed on the Action Agenda.

1. Approve Supply Bills and Expense Accounts
2. Approve Line Items Transfers as requested by County Auditor and as authorized by Local Government Code Sec. 111.010
3. Special Budget Amendment as authorized by Local Government Code Sec. 111.0706. SPECIAL BUDGET FOR GRANT OR AID MONEY which states:
(a) The county auditor shall certify to the commissioners court the receipt of all public or private grant or aid money that is available for disbursement in a fiscal year but not included in the budget for that fiscal year. On certification, the court shall adopt a special budget for the limited purpose of spending the grant or aid money for its intended purpose. Purpose of the Amendment is for receipt of grant monies received from Nortex Regional Planning Commission for one date management license used for Emergency Management purposes.
4. Special Budget Amendment as authorized by Local Government Code Sec. 111.0706. SPECIAL BUDGET FOR GRANT OR AID MONEY which states:

Purpose of the Amendment is for receipt of grant monies related to the Windthorst Water Supply project through Texas Department of Agriculture Grant \$713207.
