Any announcement of "not ready" shall be made in a detailed *Motion for Continuance* in proper form which shall contain a detailed explanation of why the case is not ready and **e-filed**. A failure to announce properly will be considered an announcement of "ready".

All Pre-Trial Motions are to be filed at least ten (10) days prior to Trial date.

The Court should be notified at least seven (7) days prior to Trial date if a Bench Warrant is necessary.

No Children under the age of 12 years old will be allowed in the courtroom.


Failure to appear punctually at the above trial setting may result in the issuance of a Judgement NISI (bond forfeiture) and a warrant for arrest of the Defendant.
