12. Consider and/or take action on funding for the Royal Theater. Jerry Phillips reminded the Court that he had given them a written report in an earlier meeting. Phillips reported the Royal Theater had to be shutdown for 16 months during covid which was a loss of \$43,000.00.

The motion was made by Todd Herring and seconded by Wade Scarbrough to approve funding in the amount of \$43,000.00 for the Royal Theater. Voting yes 1-2-3-4-Judge

13. Discuss and/or take action on purchasing Skid Unit for EMC vehicle. Shane Wright reported that small fires, he was having to use a fire extinguisher. Wright discussed the purchase of a small 125-gallon water tank to be placed in the back of the EMC pickup. Darin Wolf questioned if the American Relief Plan money could be used.

Court discussed grievance committee results: Randy Jackson reported that Jack Curd's grievance of \$67,453.00 that includes supplements and certification pay was approved with a 9 to 0 vote. Curd's raise is automatically granted.

Todd Herring discussed adjusting Justice of the Peace, Precinct 3 salary in the amount of \$17,769.00 to match Justice of the Peace, Precinct 4. Pat Martin, III reported that the Precinct 3 is 50% smaller than the other precincts. Randy Jackson informed the Court of Grievance Committee vote of 6 for and 3 against.

Motion was made by Todd Herring and seconded by Wade Scarbrough to raise Justice of the Peace, Precinct 3 \$9,000.00. Voting yes 1-4; No 2-3-Judge Motion died.

Motion was made by Darin Wolf and seconded by Todd Herring to raise Justice of the Peace, Precinct 3 \$4,000.00. Voting yes 2-4; No 1-3-Judge Motion died.

ORDER TO NOT INCREASE SALARY

Motion was made by Wade Scarbrough and seconded by Randy Jackson to not increase the Justice of the Peace, Precinct 3 salary over the 6% raise already approved. Voting yes 1-2-3-4-Judge

Randy Jackson informed the Court to consider the grievance of Dawn Vieth, Tax Assessor Collector with an 8 to 1 vote from the Grievance Committee with a \$10,000.00 salary request. **Died for lack of a motion.**

Randy Jackson informed the Court to consider the grievance of Patricia Vieth, Treasurer with an 8 to 1 vote from the Grievance Committee with a \$7,500.00 grant stipend request. **Died for lack of a motion.**

Randy Jackson informed the Court to consider the grievance of Joe Aulds, Justice of the Peace, Precinct 1 with a 7 to 2 vote from the Grievance Committee with a \$10,000.00 salary request. **Died for lack of a motion.**

Randy Jackson informed the Court to consider the grievance of Karren Winter, County Clerk with a 8 to 1 vote from the Grievance Committee with a \$10,000.00 salary request. **Died for lack of a motion.**

16. Adopt Final Budget for FYE September 30, 2023. **Paul O. Wylie, Jr. discussed** the final budget for FYE September 30, 2023.

The motion was by Pat Martin, III and seconded by Randy Jackson to approve final budget for FYE September 30, 2023. Voting yes 1-3-4-Judge; No 2

17. Adopt Tax Rate for FYE September 30, 2023. Paul O. Wylie, Jr. reported that with the increase of \$7,000.00 salary change it would not change the tax rate, which is set at 0.58873.

ORDER TO ADOPT TAX RATE

I, Pat Martin, III move that the property tax rate be increased by the adoption of a tax rate of 0.58873, which is effectively a 4.30 percent increase in the tax rate. This tax rate will add more taxes for maintenance and operations than last year's tax rate. The tax rate will raise by 4.04 percent and will raise taxes for maintenance and operations of a \$100,000 home by approximately \$-33.92, seconded by Todd Herring. Voting yes 1-3-4-Judge; No 2
