

ARCHER COUNTY LIBRARY COVID -19 PROTOCOL

In consideration of the health and safety of our patrons and staff, the Archer Public Library will implement precautions to prevent the spread of COVID-19 in two stages.

Stage 1- Effective Immediately

All due dates will be extended through the end of March. The book drop will remain available to return items, but please note it is not necessary to return items if you are in self-quarantine.

The library will remain open during its regular business hours; however, **only 1 patron** will be allowed in the library at a time for a maximum **15-minute visit**.
