

# County of Archer COVID-19 UPDATE

In regards to Executive Order No. GA-29 relating to the mandatory use of face coverings during the COVID-19 disaster.

As of today, Archer County has had a total of eight confirmed positive cases from county residents. Any county with less than 20 positive cases has the option of not mandating or forcing people to wear facial coverings in certain situations under penalty of law.

Today, I am opting out of this mandate or using our right to be exempted from this mandate for Archer County.

Please keep in mind, there have been sharp increases or spikes in positive cases recently, and the number of Archer residents that have been tested, so our positive case numbers may change quickly, and we will be forced to adhere to the Governor's Orders.

Until we reach that critical time, everyone, please stay at home if you can and use social distancing and sanitary guidelines to protect your family and community.
