

## DECLARATION OF LOCAL DISASTER IN ARCHER COUNTY, TEXAS

**WHEREAS**, Archer County on the 22<sup>nd</sup> of October, 2018, has suffered widespread damage, injury, or loss of life and/or property (or the imminent threat of the same) from;

Flood damage to local residents and rural county roads, and;

**WHEREAS**, Randy Jackson, County Judge of Archer County has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect or rehabilitate property,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED** By Randy Jackson, County Judge of Archer County: That a local State Of Disaster is hereby declared for Archer County pursuant to 418.108(a) of the *Texas Government Code*.


**Pursuant to 418.018(b)** of the *Texas Government Code*, the state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days from the date of this declaration unless continued or renewed by the Commissioners Court of Archer County.

**Pursuant to 418.018(c)** of the *Texas Government Code*, this declaration of a local state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the Archer County Clerk.

**Pursuant to 418.018(d)** of the *Texas Government Code*, this declaration of a local disaster activates the Archer County emergency management plan.


This declaration shall take effect immediately from and after it's issuance.
